NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 All class rules prohibiting marine band radios and cellular telephones are waived.

2 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all CCYC one design classes. Additional classes that are suitable for sailing upon the open waters of Lake Michigan may contact the Regatta Committee for an invitation.
- 2.2 Skippers shall be active members in good standing with their respective class organizing authority.

3 ENTRY

- 3.1 An eligible boat shall enter by lodging a completed Entry Form not later than September 19, 2009.
- 3.2 Entry Forms are available with this NOR and on the club's website at <http://www.corinthian.org/rhodes/hobelman/> or at CCYC.

4 FEES

- 4.1 To celebrate the 75th Anniversary of CCYC Entry is FREE!

5.2 Number of Races

The number of races each day is at the discretion of the Race Committee. No race will start later than 1500 on Sunday.

6 MEASUREMENTS

A current valid class measurement certificate shall be presented at registration, if required by individual class rules.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at registration

8 VENUE

Racing shall take place upon the open waters of Lake Michigan approximately one mile east of Montrose Point.

9 SCORING

9.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.2 The Low Point System of Appendix A is amended as follows:

- (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total for her race scores.
- (b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10 BERTHING

Keelboats normally berthed outside of Montrose Harbor may sail to the racing area from their homeport and may return to their homeport after the day's racing. Competitors are reminded to follow the checkout procedure.

11 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keelboats may be hauled during the regatta.

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to boats finishing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in each class with seven or more entrants.

Prizes will be awarded to boats finishing 1st or 2nd in each class with four to six entrants.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for materials damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
