

The Doris Tschudy 5th Annual Women's Regatta
CCYC Montrose Harbor, Sunday, July 18, 2010
SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ENTRIES

Competitors enter by confirming participation with Deanna Trejo (deanna.trejo@att.net) before 10 AM on July 18, 2010.

3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the Chicago Corinthian Yacht Club.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole located on the CCYC front lawn. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 1 hour after AP is lowered.

5 SCHEDULE

A competitors' meeting will be held at 10:00 AM on July 18, 2010 at CCYC. The warning signal for the first race will be 12 Noon on July 17, 2010. Subsequent races will be held as soon as possible after the end of the previous race. No race will be started after 3:30 PM.

6 RACING AREA

The racing area will be the CCYC sailing circle east of Montrose Harbor entrance.

7 COURSES and MARKS

The courses will be WL2, WL4 or B. The course will be designated by black lettering on a white board. Marks will be either the fixed pins on the sailing circle or an orange tetrahedron for the windward mark. Leeward mark will be the center pin of the sailing circle. The attached diagram shows the courses, course designations, the marks in order and the rounding direction of each mark.

8 STARTING AND FINISHING LINES

The starting and finishing lines will be between the committee boat's orange flag and the center pin of the CCYC sailing circle.

9 TIME LIMIT

The time limit for each race will be 1½ hrs for the first boat to finish.

10 PROTESTS

Protests shall be delivered to CCYC within 1 hour after the race committee finish boat docks. Hearings will be held the following Thursday at CCYC.

11 SCORING

All scores will count. Three races are scheduled. One race constitutes a regatta series. A woman must be at the helm to be scored.

12 TROPHIES

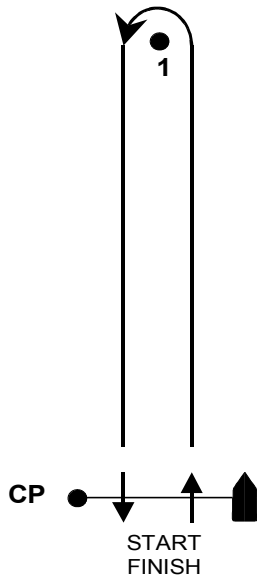
Trophies will be awarded to top 3 scorers.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

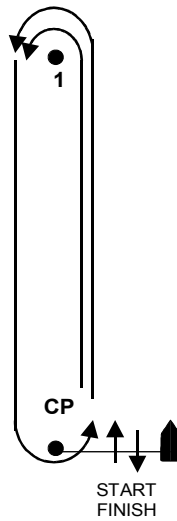
